PG Pool as it is universally known, is a private pool run by its members. Located in Mount Rainier, MD, it is the perfect setting for a relaxing swim or picnic throughout the summer season. This welcoming, safe and family-friendly environment is located just minutes away from many communities in Prince George's and Montgomery counties and the District of Columbia, including Brookland, University Park, Hyattsville, Cheverly, Takoma Park, Bladensburg, Riverdale Park, College Park, Capitol Hill, Mount Pleasant, Adams Morgan and many more. Only members and their guests may use PG Pool, which is open from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend.
